Scott's Corner

On behalf of the clergy and staff of St. Agnes Catholic Church, please allow me this opportunity to wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving. For those that may be traveling to see loved ones, may God bless you with a safe journey. After watching a disturbing piece on the evening news last night, allow me to also wish you luck as the forecast for air travel this holiday season is dismal. We look forward to seeing everyone back in Paradise sooner than later.

Time is running out for the Pension Protection Act which will expire at the end of this year. Our financial representative has indicated that most money managers/financial advisors have set the date of December 7, 2007 for the cutoff to make such a gift. For those that are not familiar with the Pension Protection Act, here is a brief summary:

Have you taken advantage of the favorable IRS regulations (Pension Protection Act) regarding distributions from your IRA? Many of you have done so, however many more may not be aware of this opportunity which will expire in 2007. In an attempt to increase philanthropic giving, the IRS has created a two (2) year window in which distributions from your IRA may be directed to a charitable organization tax free. Once an individual attains the age of 70 1/2, he or she is required to begin taking minimum distributions from their IRA. This distribution is taxed at the individual's particular tax bracket (15%, 25%, 28%, etc...). For the remainder of the 2007 tax year, you may choose to gift your distribution (up to \$100,000) directly to your favorite charity (i.e. St. Agnes, St. Vincent de Paul, Catholic Faith Appeal) completely tax free. This is a great opportunity to make a one time gift without the federal government getting their "cut". Please see your financial advisor or tax professional to obtain the forms necessary to make your gift.

The aforementioned Pension Protection Act is a great opportunity to make a tax free gift in order to assist us in lowering our debt, help our local families in need through St. Vincent de Paul, lowering our CFA goal or simply assisting in our many ongoing programs at St. Agnes.

As the year end approaches, I have received numerous calls regarding the donation of stock. In year's past, we have had our own brokerage account to which you could make stock gifts directly. All stock gifts are now being processed through the Diocese of Venice for the benefit of St. Agnes. If you would like to make such a year end stock gift, call the Diocese of Venice at 941-484-9543 and ask for the development office. They will handle the transfer for you and allocate the funds as you request. You may split your gift however you like (i.e. 50% for general operating, 25% Debt Reduction, 15% CFA, 10% St. Vincent de Paul). The DOV will acknowledge your gift and notify us of the transfer and allocation. You will then receive an acknowledgement from St. Agnes. Your annual statement will also reflect the gift.

The Ladies of St. Agnes have announced that the proceeds from their Fall Bazaar totaled \$10,000.00. These incredibly talented and generous women prepare all year long for this annual event which took place on October 27 & 28. This past Wednesday, the Ladies of St. Agnes informed Fr. Bob that they are going to distribute a check in the amount of \$10,000.00 to be used for debt reduction. Thank you very much ladies for all of your hard work and generous gift.

As you know, plans are underway for installation of a large crucifix above the altar and for kneelers in all of the pews. Would you like to make a donation towards the purchase of either of these items? The cross for the crucifix is being fabricated locally at no cost however the corpus will be much more intricate which means the cost will be commensurate. The crucifix will make a fine addition to the sanctuary and contrast beautifully with the Risen Christ currently in place. With respect to the kneelers, it is expected that delivery will take place sometime in January with installation immediately following. If you would like to make a donation for either the crucifix or the kneelers, you may drop a check in the basket with a notation of how you would like to allocate you gift. Thank you in advance for your consideration.

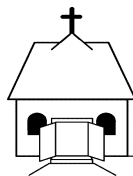

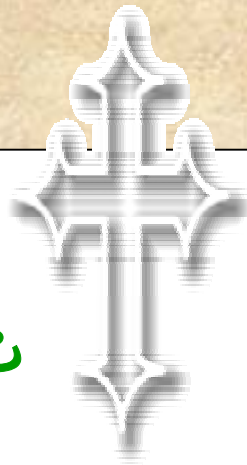
