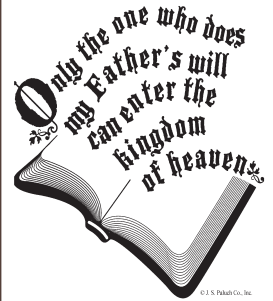

Scott's Corner

We have reached an important financial milestone! With five more weekends to go in the current fiscal year, we have broken the \$1 million dollar mark in regular offertory collections. Believe it or not, revenue from all sources is over \$1.5 million this fiscal year to date. Thank you to everyone for your support in helping us reach this milestone and for your continued generosity.

We are hopeful that the Holy Family sculpture will have been installed in time for the vigil Mass this Saturday. Please take a moment and stop by our new sculpture and have a look. I think the end result is absolutely beautiful. Thank you once again to the Ladies of St. Agnes for their purchase of this magnificent piece.

Thank you for your continued support of the Catholic Faith Appeal. Contributions remain steady as we head into the summer months. I have had several recent requests from the Diocese of Venice asking that our parishioners please make their checks payable to the **Catholic Faith Appeal or CFA** with St. Agnes in the memo line. They have returned checks in the past for this very reason and are threatening to do so again. Even if you use the blue CFA envelope, you must make your check payable to the CFA and not to St. Agnes. As you can understand, it is not an ideal situation with the Diocese of Venice depositing a check made payable to St. Agnes into their bank account. In addition, the argument could be made that if a check were made payable to St. Agnes with nothing in the memo line, we could enter CFA on the blank line and send the check to the Diocese to be credited to our CFA goal, even if that wasn't the donor's intention.

We are all very well aware of Paul Todd's musical talent; however you may be unaware of his philanthropic efforts through Paul Todd Charities. This not for profit organization was created in 2005 in order to assist smaller organizations with fundraising. Recipients have included the Ricky King Fund, Sunlight Home, JOP Education Fund and Voices of the Children of Southwest Florida. It has since branched out to include Habitat for Humanity and Feed the Children. In 2007, Paul Todd Charities donated over \$77,000 to these very worthwhile causes. The major revenue source for Paul's Charity is concerts; however he also generates revenue through his annual PTC Gala, his TV show and numerous other ventures. Paul Todd Charities will be hosting a concert event that will include Billy Dean & Dawn on July 1st at St. John the Evangelist in order to recognize the members of our armed forces and their ultimate sacrifice. Proceeds from the event will be used to benefit our "*wounded warriors*", the heroes of our country. Preferred seating is \$100 and general seating is \$20. Tickets will be on sale after all Masses. Paul is very excited about this venture and invites everyone to come out and support our troops. Thank you Paul for all your great work within our parish and throughout the community.

My optimism for the success or survival of the summer golf tournament is waning. After making my initial plea this past weekend, I had only two groups contact me to register. Could it be that due to the holiday weekend there were many golfers out of town? Or could it be that there is very little interest in participating in a golf tournament in late June? Whatever the case, I am going to include the flyer for one more week in hopes that this was some sort of anomaly. If we do not have a decent response after this weekend we will have to cancel the tournament. I definitely am scratching my head on this one. I have hosted over 20 tournaments for St. John the Evangelist and/or St. Agnes in the past and filled them nearly every time. Those tournaments were in the fall and spring rather than the middle of summer; however the complete lack of response this time is confusing. The purpose of this tournament is not to make a lot of money but rather to host parish events throughout the summer in an attempt to further build community. 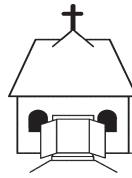

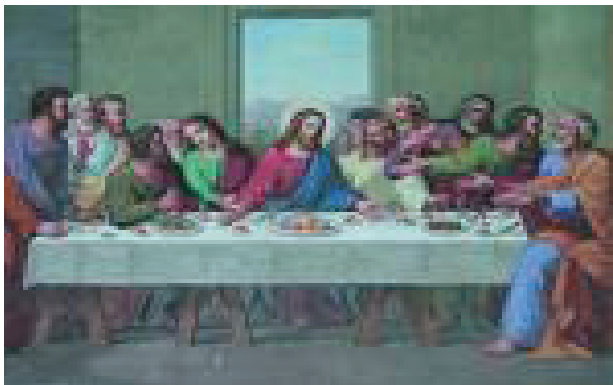
