### From the Desk of Fr. Bob

We are blessed to enjoy the service of two permanent deacons at St. Agnes. Parishioners who attend the 4:00 Vigil Mass on Saturdays know Deacon Virgil Glocheski, who recently celebrated his 93<sup>rd</sup> birthday! A belated Happy Birthday Deacon Virgil, and may God continue to bless you in your life and service to us! I deeply appreciate Deacon Virgil's wit, wisdom and generosity to our community. He lives the Gospel that he proclaims and he has been a blessing to all of us at St. Agnes.

Deacon Ed McCarthy may have a long way to go to catch up to Deacon Virgil in the birthday department, but he is celebrating a milestone anniversary of his own in service to the People of God this year. 2008 marks his 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary in the permanent diaconate! He was ordained for the Archdiocese of Cleveland as the Church's re-established the permanent diaconate after the Second Vatican Council. We are fortunate to have him here seasonally. In addition to assisting at Sunday and weekday Masses, Deacon Ed works in baptismal preparation and I have most recently asked him to assist me in organizing a parish pastoral council. When I came here he joked with me about having to "break in another new pastor," (at least I thought it was a joke!), and I have indeed come to highly value his advice and counsel. When he was up north for the summer and fall, I truly missed him here and I hope that you can join me in encouraging Deacon Ed and his wife Jane to extend their seasonal stays! Both Ed and Jane are preparing a very special Stations of the Cross for our parish for Good Friday evening. Keep an eye on the bulletin for the details.

Deacon Ed will be honored and serve as a deacon to Bishop Dewane at the Chrism Mass on Tuesday of Holy Week. Father John and I will also renew the promises we made at our ordination at the Chrism Mass. I invite all of you who are able and interested to attend the Chrism Mass Tuesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 a.m. at the Cathedral in Venice in honor of Deacon Ed and perhaps as a new and wonderful aspect of your celebration of Holy Week. The three oils that are used in the parishes of the Diocese for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Anointing of the Sick are blessed at this Mass. As part of the ceremony, Deacons will process with three large flasks of olive oil to be blessed in the sanctuary by the Bishop. Some of you might not know that the oil used in the sacraments is blessed by the Bishop at this time. It is a reminder of the Bishop's apostolic connection to the sacramental ministry that takes place at every parish. As priests and deacons, we are able to perform our ministries by virtue of our connection to the Bishop. I hope that some of our parishioners can join us on this very special day.

## Scott's Corner

After what I would consider (with the exception of two 2 day cold snaps) one of the mildest winters in recent memory in Southwest Florida, the Tabebuia trees are beginning to bloom signaling the beginning of spring. Such is not the case up north where this has been one of the worst winters in recent memory. I am sure that our seasonal residents are thrilled to be riding out the winter months in paradise. It is hard to believe that due to an incredibly early Easter this year, we will be celebrating the resurrection of our Lord in only two short weeks. Hopefully, due to the fact that many of our seasonal parishioners arrived later this past fall, you will be staying a little longer this spring.

In addition, There will be CFA brochures and pledge envelopes provided in the narthex this weekend so that you may make a pledge or simply read about all of the programs supported by your donations.

At the end of this fiscal year (June 30), we will be purging all of the families from our database that have no attendance history for the past fiscal year (July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2008.) As you know, the only way of tracking attendance is by the use of weekly envelopes; therefore if you have not submitted envelopes during the past fiscal year, your record will be deleted. If you are registered and do not use envelopes and do not wish to be deleted, please contact Sarah in the parish office to ensure that your record is preserved. The purpose for performing this year end purge is to save money in envelope printing and mailing costs.

And now for the not so good news. Weber Road will be closed at Vanderbilt Beach Road from March 10<sup>th</sup> through March 21<sup>st</sup>. There are not that many parishioners using Weber as an exit from our parking lot currently, however for those that are, your only option for these 11 days will be Vanderbilt Beach Road. As an aside, I was leaving the 10:30 Mass this past Sunday from the least strategic parking place on our campus or immediately behind the altar. This meant that I had to wait for all of the traffic from the east lot to filter in before I was able to begin my trek towards the exit. It was a very slow go initially and I actually did not move for 8 minutes, however ultimately I was out of the parking lot and through the light at Collier Blvd. in 22 minutes. Considering that this was a very crowded Mass (standing room only), I was not overly irritated with the amount of time required to exit the parking lot.

For those that are applying for tuition subsidy through St. Agnes for the upcoming school year at St. Ann, St. Elizabeth Seton or St. John Neumann, please see the tuition subsidy criteria published below. You must meet all three criteria to be considered for a subsidy. In addition to meeting the aforementioned criteria, each family requesting subsidy must have completed a FACTS form.

### Tuition Subsidy Criterion

- ❖ In order for your child to be eligible for a tuition subsidy at either St. Ann, St. Elizabeth Seton or St. John Neumann, the following criterion must be met.
- ❖ The family must have been parishioners at St. Agnes for 6 months prior to the initial request.
- ❖ The family must regularly attend mass (i.e., regularly attending mass is defined as weekly attendance.)
- ❖ The family must be contributing on a regular basis.

The only way to accurately monitor attendance and donations is by use of weekly envelopes. If you do not place your envelope in the collection basket, then there is absolutely no record of your attendance or contribution.

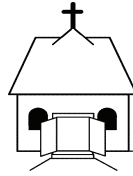

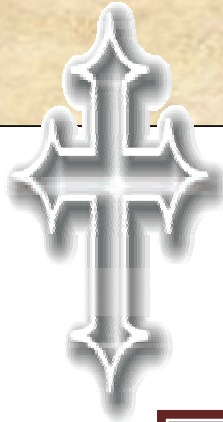

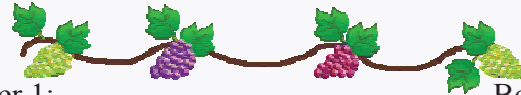
