She admits to treasuring being an active part of the Saint Agnes community. Karen said that she feels truly blessed to be part of such a special parish and to be able to "work for my Lord."

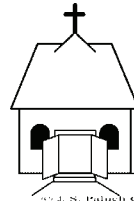

¿QUIÉNES SOMOS?

¿Quiénes son el "nosotros" cuando cantamos
"nosotros somos su pueblo, ovejas de su rebaño" en el
salmo responsorial? Es muy fácil pensar que se trata sola-
mente de nosotros, en esta misa, o sólo los miembros de
esta parroquia o diócesis, o tal vez pensamos que somos
sólo los católicos en los Estados Unidos. Pero el
"nosotros" es mucho más grande y amplio. Si tomas un
globo o un atlas entre tus manos, te resultará difícil seña-
lar un lugar o tierra donde "nosotros" no estamos cantan-
do ese salmo hoy. No sólo eso, sino que "nosotros" so-
mos los santos que sobrevivieron la gran persecución,
como describe la lectura de hoy del Apocalipsis. Y el

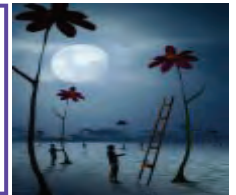

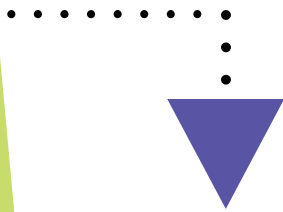

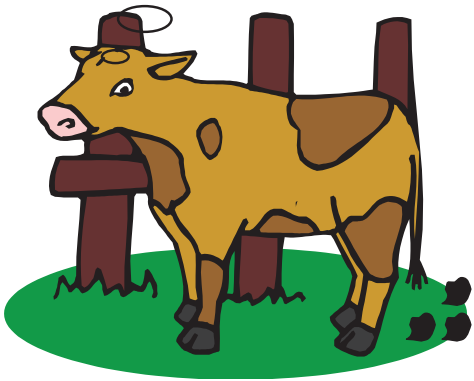
