*Mark your calendars for September 13-23, 2010.*



Join Fr. Bob and other members of St. Agnes Parish on an incredible journey to Italy. Some of the trip highlights include visiting **Venice** with Mass at **St. Marks**, a gondola ride through the canals, and viewing of Michelangelo's statue of



David in **Florence**. A visit to the **Leaning Tower of Pisa** precedes a visit to the Tuscan spa resort of **Montecatini**. Time will be spent in **Assisi**, the home of St. Francis, and a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. In **Rome** expect a Papal audience, Mass at **St. Peters**, a tour of the Vatican Museums and Michelangelo's famous depiction of the Creation in the **Sistine Chapel**, followed by a visit to the Colosseum and the Forum.

Traveling south will lead the trip to view **Naples** and the **Bay of Naples**, tour **Pompeii**, and see the ruins of a city buried by Mt. Vesuvius in 79AD. A visit to the **Isle of Capri** includes the funicular train ride up to the main village for shopping and enjoying the views over the Mediterranean Sea. This is followed by a trip to Sorrento to view the cliffs Amalfi coast which overlooks **Mt. Vesuvius** and the Sea of Naples. On the way back to Rome, a visit to the **Monastery of Montecassino**, headquarters of the Benedictine order, is planned. The trip will conclude with a farewell dinner in Rome.

Land Price is \$2822.60 per person and includes 9 nights in hotels, 9 breakfasts, 5 dinners, private tour guide and luxury coach, Mass daily, and entrance fees to all mentioned sites. Airfare is currently \$839.00 out of Regional Southwest Florida International Airport (Ft. Myers) but is subject to change until paid in full. Airfare can be arranged from any major city in the eastern United States for little or no extra cost. Flight arrangements can be made on your own or with the group. Deposit is \$100 for air and \$300 for the land. Final payment is due July 1, 2010. Pick up registration forms from the parish office or phone 941-737-9143 for more information.

The connection between the "paschal banquet" of the Old Testament and our traditional blessing of the prepared foods on Easter Sunday continues to this day. Jesus described our experience of heaven as "a great banquet." Thus, eating the Easter food reminds us that we are part of the "divine joy of Christ's kingdom."

Food Blessing (*Swienconka*) is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions. On Holy Saturday, we bring decorated baskets to the church to be blessed. The baskets contain a sampling of the food that will be served at Easter dinner, symbolic of the Easter story:

- Hard boiled eggs...symbolize life & Christ's resurrection
- Bread...symbolic of Jesus son of God & son of Man
- Lamb...represents Christ as the perfect sacrifice
- Salt...represents purification
- Horseradish...reminds us of the bitter sacrifice of Christ
- Ham...shows great joy & abundance

*Having prepared ourselves during Lent, we, the faithful eat the blessed food on Easter Sunday and the days following Easter!*
