Ray Sollitto



This week we acknowledge and thank Ray Sollitto for his stewardship at Saint Agnes Parish. Ray has been a parishioner of Saint Agnes since its beginning and has lived in Naples for the last ten years. Right after joining the Saint Agnes family, Ray volunteered his time to serve with the Knights of Columbus. He is a fourth degree Knight and past Deputy Grand Knight. He is also an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist. Thirty five years ago when his father died, Ray experienced a profound conversion. The sacraments became a priority in his life and he was led to intensive Bible study. Ray joined a Charismatic Prayer group. He experienced a yearning to proclaim God's Word to the Assembly of His people and then became a Lector. When the Lector Coordinator position opened, it became easy for him to accept this privilege because he was eager to help other Lectors publicly speak God's Word. Inspired by Isaiah's words, Ray heartily proclaims "Jesus indeed is my Savior; I am confident and unafraid. My strength and my courage is the Lord and He is my Savior."

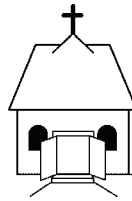

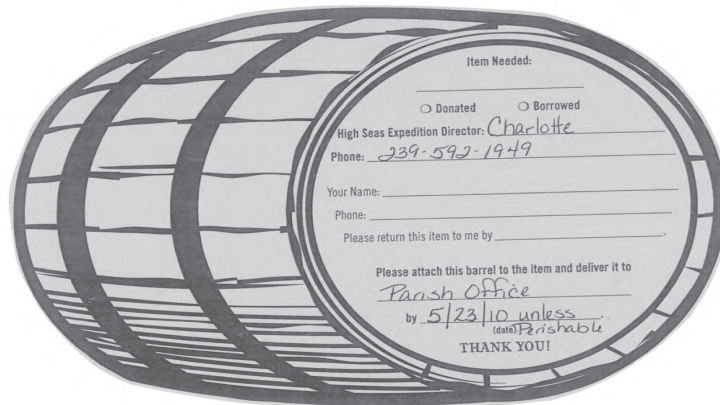

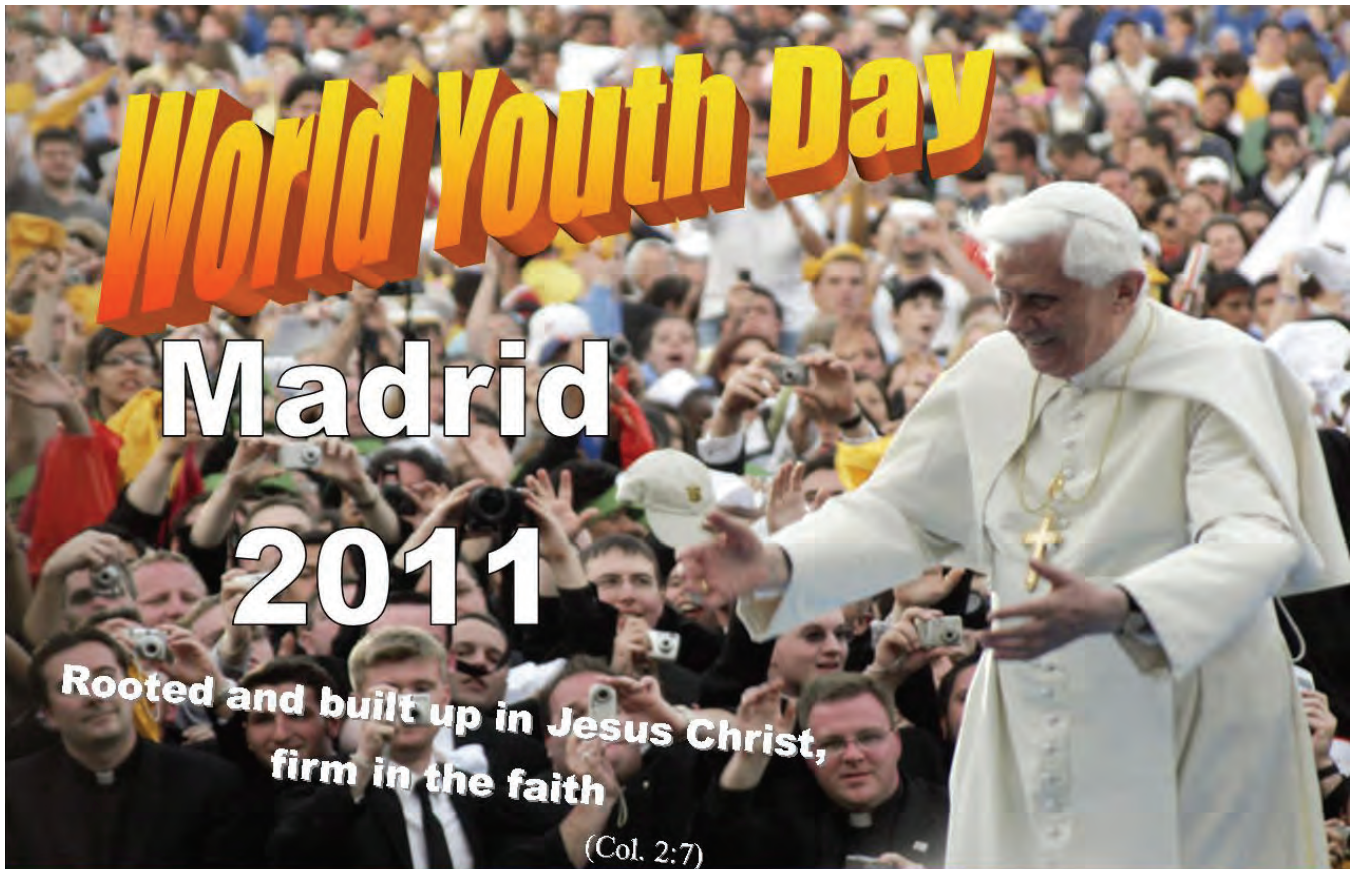
