AT THE END

In the coming weeks, as we draw nearer to the end of the liturgical year, we will often hear references to the end of our lives and the end of time. This week's scriptures are no exception. The reading from Timothy warns us to live "without stain or reproach until the appearance of our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Timothy 6:14), and the psalm says that God "secures justice for the oppressed . . . but the way of the wicked he thwarts" (Psalm 146:7, 9). In the reading from Amos we hear about the "woe" that is in store for the complacent rich, who think nothing of how their self-indulgence oppresses the poor. The Gospel parable about Lazarus and the nameless rich man exemplifies such complacency, as well as the justice that both the wicked and the oppressed will experience beyond the grave. 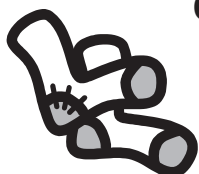

# JOURNEY OF FAITH

*Our parish has begun a new journey into the faith for adults interested in becoming Catholic... every Sunday after the 9am Mass in the Chapel.* Weekly sessions are a time of

This process of welcome into the Catholic Church is called the RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (often identified by its initials: RCIA). Please invite those you think would benefit from these sessions and offer to come with them to at least one. If you are already Catholic but have not received First Communion or Confirmation yet, we invite you into full communion with the Church through an adapted RCIA curriculum.

A question of many, "At this time I have no intention of joining the Church, but I want to learn more about Catholicism. Is there a place for me in the RCIA process?" Yes, the Inquiry Group is for you! You are never obligated to move from "Inquiry" to the next step of preparation to join the Church called the "Catechumenate."
