### IN GOD ALONE

Isaiah speaks to us today of Cyrus, King of Persia, anointed by the Lord. God calls Cyrus by name and leads him in service to the Israelites. In this passage we hear that it is the Lord who gives Cyrus his title, who arms him against his enemies, and who opens doors and unbars gates before him. And God does all of this so that the people will know that "I am the LORD," and that "there is none besides me" (Isaiah 45:6).

Paul opens his letter with essentially the same notion—that in God alone we find our grace and peace. Paul also gives thanks to God on our behalf, calling to mind our work of faith, hope, and love. And in the familiar Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Pharisees to give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's.

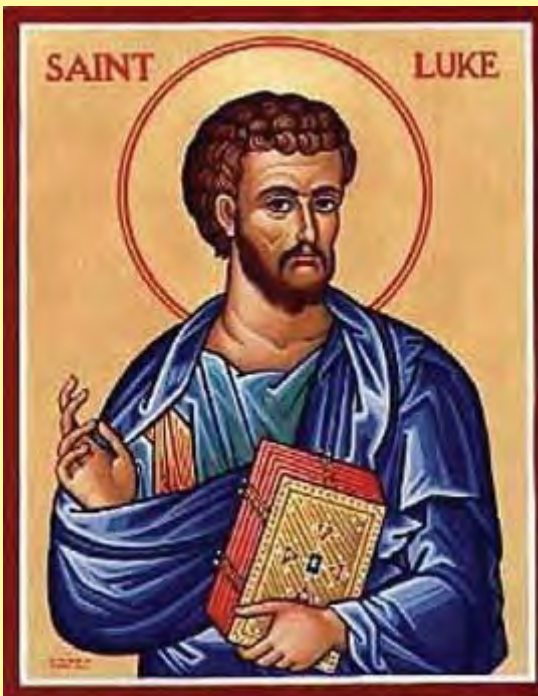
## St. Agnes Parish 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual International Festival

A candle will be reserved to memorialize your loved one **only** if you call the parish office in advance with the deceased name by October 28<sup>th</sup>.

Gather with parishioners as a community of faith at the 7:00 p.m. liturgy on Wednesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, particularly those who have lost a loved one. May faith be your consolation and eternal life be your hope.



### The St. Vincent De Paul Society

Although the **St. Vincent De Paul Society** is responsible for the semi-annual food drives and the St. Patrick's Day event, the volunteers also provide the following services to those in need. These services are provided year round by the 7 parishes that make up the Naples Council of the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

- **Meals on Wheels** – approximately 200 volunteers throughout the year who deliver about 85,000 meals donating the use of their cars and gas for deliveries (less than 90 volunteers during the summer)
- **Casework** – we have about 120 volunteers throughout the year who assisted a little over 15,000 children and adults with personal services such as assistance in paying rent, FPL, water bills, health services and more. (less than 50 caseworkers among all seven conferences during the summer)
- **Thrift Stores** – For the two stores there are about 290 volunteers who accept donations, sort and price items, and work as cashiers (less than 90 volunteers during the summer)

## OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

**HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY** The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Apostles' Creed*, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The *Our Father*, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*. The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and—added by Pope John II in 2002—the Luminous. The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer related to each Mystery. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group.

The **Five Joyful Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on the Mondays, Saturdays, and Sundays of Advent:

1. The Annunciation
2. The Visitation
3. The Nativity
4. The Presentation in the Temple
5. The Finding in the Temple

The **Five Sorrowful Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on the Tuesday, Friday, and Sundays of Lent:

1. The Agony in the Garden
2. The Scourging at the Pillar
3. The Crowning with Thorns
4. The Carrying of the Cross
5. The Crucifixion and Death

The **Five Glorious Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on the Wednesday and Sundays outside of Lent and Advent:

1. The Resurrection
2. The Ascension
3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit
4. The Assumption
5. The Coronation of Mary

The **Five Luminous Mysteries** are traditionally prayed on Thursdays:

1. The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan
2. The Wedding Feast at Cana
3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God
4. The Transfiguration
5. The Institution of the Eucharist

### Praying the Rosary

Familiarize yourself and/or your group with the prayers of the rosary. (These prayers along with this entire article can be found in the "Parent Articles" section in the "Faith Formation" tab of the parish website: [www.StAgnesNaples.org](http://www.StAgnesNaples.org))

1. Make the Sign of the Cross.
2. Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apstles' Creed*.
3. On the first bead, say an *Our Father*.
4. Say three *Hail Marys* on each of the next three beads.
5. Say the *Glory Be*
6. For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery, then say the *Our Father*.
7. While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten *Hail Marys* while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*. (After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.")
8. After saying the five decades, say the "Hail, Holy Queen, followed by this dialogue and prayer:  
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
