Parent's Checklist for Confirmation Preparation Year 2

Pre-requisite: complete year 1 and registration paperwork. All items must be complete by 5/3/20 so that Confirmation be not delayed.

*All paperwork is included in the red Confirmation orientation folder.

Reach out to us early with any concerns; we are here to work with you to make the best plan for your family.

Community

- Sign up for a service hour opportunity (list of options on the back of the service log, deadline 10/13/19).*
- Submit service hour log with at least 15 hours complete (cultivates generous participation in community).*
- Turn in completed sponsor form (a local sponsor is preferable because their role to assist parents throughout preparation and beyond; if you do not know anyone qualified, we can help you find someone; due 10/13/19).*

Knowledge

- Participate in at least 15 Life Nights (see white Youth Group Calendar, don't forget to sign in).* or provide proof of Catholic school/homeschool religious education.
- Participate in all the events on the Confirmation Year 2 calendar (see reverse).
- Prepare for a written/oral exam using the Confirmation Study Guide.*



Spirituality

- Regular Sunday Mass attendance (at least 15 at St. Agnes using Children's Envelopes, see envelope box for instructions).
- Complete the "My Confirmation Name Essay" about a canonized saint (of the same gender as the student) to help them reflect on their unique call to live a faithful Catholic life (due 10/13/19).*
- Participate in at least one retreat (more details by email will be sent):
 1. October 26, 2019 Respect Life Conference at St. Agnes (ticket details TBD).
 2. November 2, 2019 Youth Rally (tickets/transportation included in class fee, permission slip required).*
 3. January 22-26, 2020 March for Life in Washington, DC (trip fee: \$600).*
 4. March 21, 2020 St. Agnes Hard As Nails retreat at parish center (9:30am-5pm, 5:15pm Mass with families and sponsor).
 5. April 17-19, 2020 Diocesan NET retreat in Venice, FL (tickets/transportation not included in class fee, TBD).
 6. April 26, 2020 St. Agnes NET retreat at parish center (9:30am-4:45pm, 5pm Mass with families and sponsor. Fee included in class fee. All candidates who have not yet attended a retreat are expected.)
