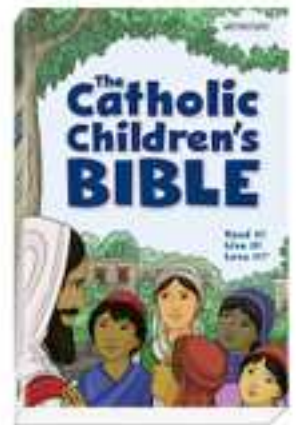
How to use the Catholic Children's Bible at Home.
